## I. LOCATION OF TROOPS

See attached Situation Map (Incl 1).

## II. ARMY FORCES

1. Eighth United States Army.

## a. I US Corps.

## (1) 25th Infantry Division.

(a) 24th RCT (-): Attacked north at 070800L. Advanced against light enemy resistance to vic CS0643, six miles northwest of ANYANG-NI CS1641.

(b) 27th RCT (3d Bn, 24th Inf attached): 1st Bn reinforced (Tank-Infantry Task Force) advanced to vic CS1543, one mile north of ANYANG-NI, against light enemy resistance. 2d Bn reinforced (Tank-Infantry Task Force) advanced to vic CS1041, three miles west of ANYANG-NI, against light enemy resistance. 3d Bn established blocking positions in vic CS1435, one mile east of ANSAN CS1236. 3d Bn, 24th RCT, secured the SUWON CS2427 airstrip.

(c) 35th RCT: Advanced to vic CS1443, one mile north of ANYANG-NI, against light enemy resistance.

(d) 1st Turkish Armed Forces Command: 1st and 3d Bns advanced to vic CS1041 and CS1341, immediately west of ANYANG-NI, behind 2d Bn, 27th RCT, reinforced, against very light enemy resistance. 2d Bn positions not reported.

(e) 15th ROK Regt: Advanced to vic CS2039 - CS2339, four miles southeast of ANYANG-NI, with no reported enemy resistance.

## (2) 3d Infantry Division.

(a) 7th RCT: Advanced to vic CS3540 - CS3837, five miles southwest of KYONGAN-NI CS4641; status of contact not reported.

(b) 15th RCT: Elements advanced to vic CS3239, seven miles northwest of YONGIN CS3328, where attack was held up by an enemy minefield; further results not reported. Remainder of RCT in assembly area vic CS3232, three miles northwest of YONGIN.

(c) 65th RCT: Established and maintained blocking positions from vic CS2638 to vic CS3136, seven miles northeast of SUWON, with no reported enemy contact.

(3) 29th Inf Brig Group (UK): Continued in assembly area vic CSAN CS2813; patrolled MSR with no reported enemy contact.

Secondary target: HAMHUNG CV7518, visually or by radar.

(b) 91st Recon Sq: Complete BDA previously assigned and conduct pre-strike photography of specific targets in North KOREA.

(2) Fifth Air Force:

(a) Fighter and Bomber Wings: Attack and destroy specific RR bridge targets, maintain air superiority, perform close support, interdiction and cover as required. Provide escort upon request by BOMCOM. Conduct armed reconnaissance against North Korean airfields and both day and night armed reconnaissance of enemy lines of communication leading from the battle area. With substantial daily effort conduct armed recon of enemy lines of communications from KANGGYE BA9738 - HUICHON BV6849 to PYONGYANG YD3822 and from CHANGJIN CA4530 to H.GARU-RI CV5271 to HAMHUNG CV7518. With maximum B-26 aircraft attack rolling stock along line of communication from HOERYONG EB6298 to CHONGJIN EB6725 to HAMHUNG to WONSAN CU6535.

(b) 315th Air Div (Combat Cargo): Conduct cargo, troop transport, and air evacuation as required. Conduct leaflet drop over enemy troop positions.

V. RESULTS OF OPERATIONS

5. Eighth US Army:

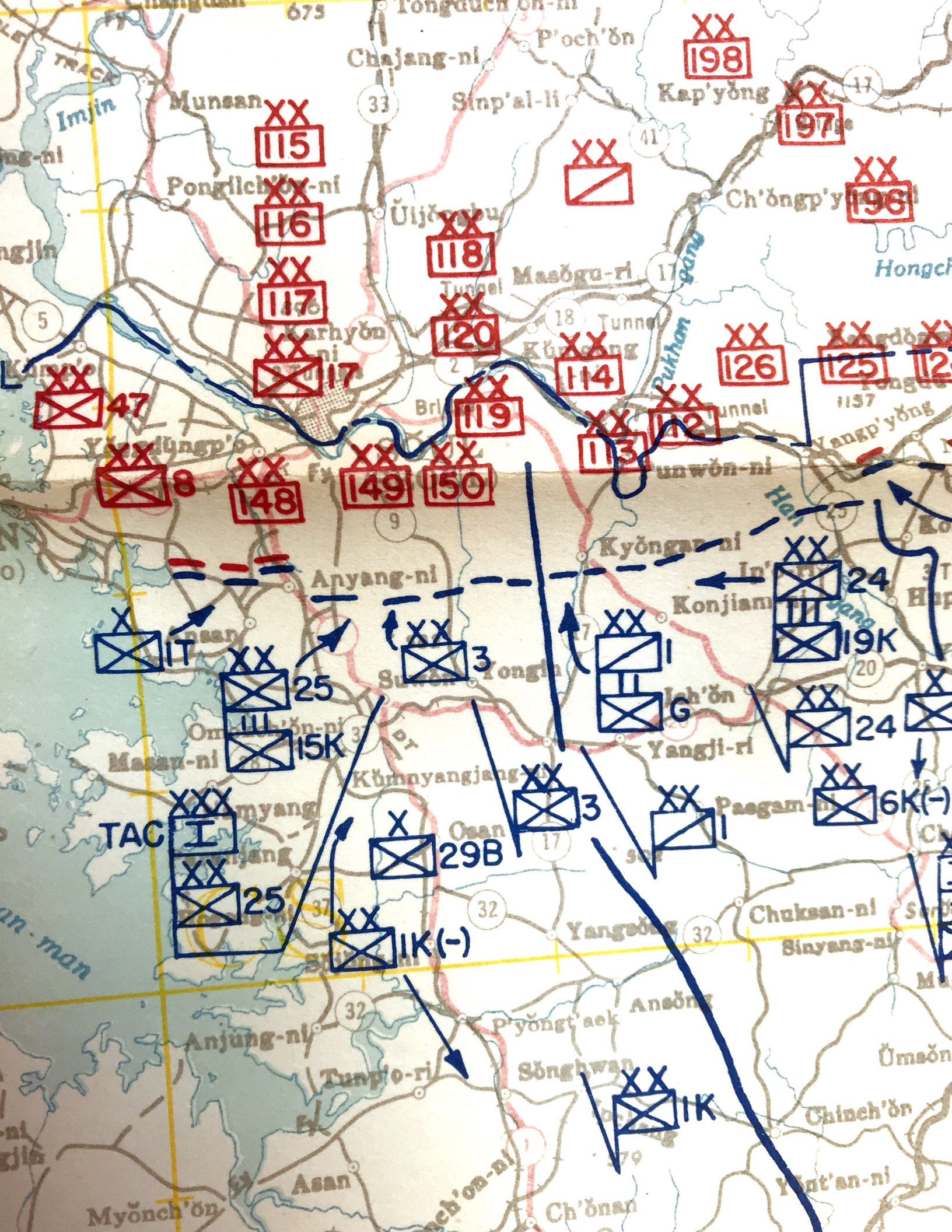
a. I US Corps: 25th Inf Div and 3d Inf Div continued advance toward the HAN River in the area between ANSAN CS1236 and KYONGAN-NI CS4641 against light enemy resistance. 29th Inf Brig Group (UK) remained vic OSAN CS2813. ROK 1st Div maintained security of the OSAN - CHOCHIWON CR4851 - TAEJON CR5921 road.

b. IX US Corps: 1st Cav Div (Inf) and 24th Inf Div continued advance toward the HAN River in the area between KYONGAN-NI and YOJU CS7928. ROK 6th Div remained in assembly areas vic ICHON CS6227 and north of CHUKSAN-NI CS5903. Elements 27th Br Com Inf Brig patrolled from vic YOJU; remainder continued in assembly area in vic CHANGHONGON-NI CS7807.

c. X US Corps: 2d Inf Div maintained positions north and northeast of YOJU and vic WONJU DSO733; continued to support attack
